The Spotted Tree Frog lives in freshwater streams in alpine Victoria and New South Wales.



It has disappeared from over 50% of its known sites and is **Critically Endangered**.

Zoo breeding programs are in place to release juvenile frogs into their alpine habitat, and **you can help!**

You buy a bag, we breed and release frogs to the wild. Together we help a species.

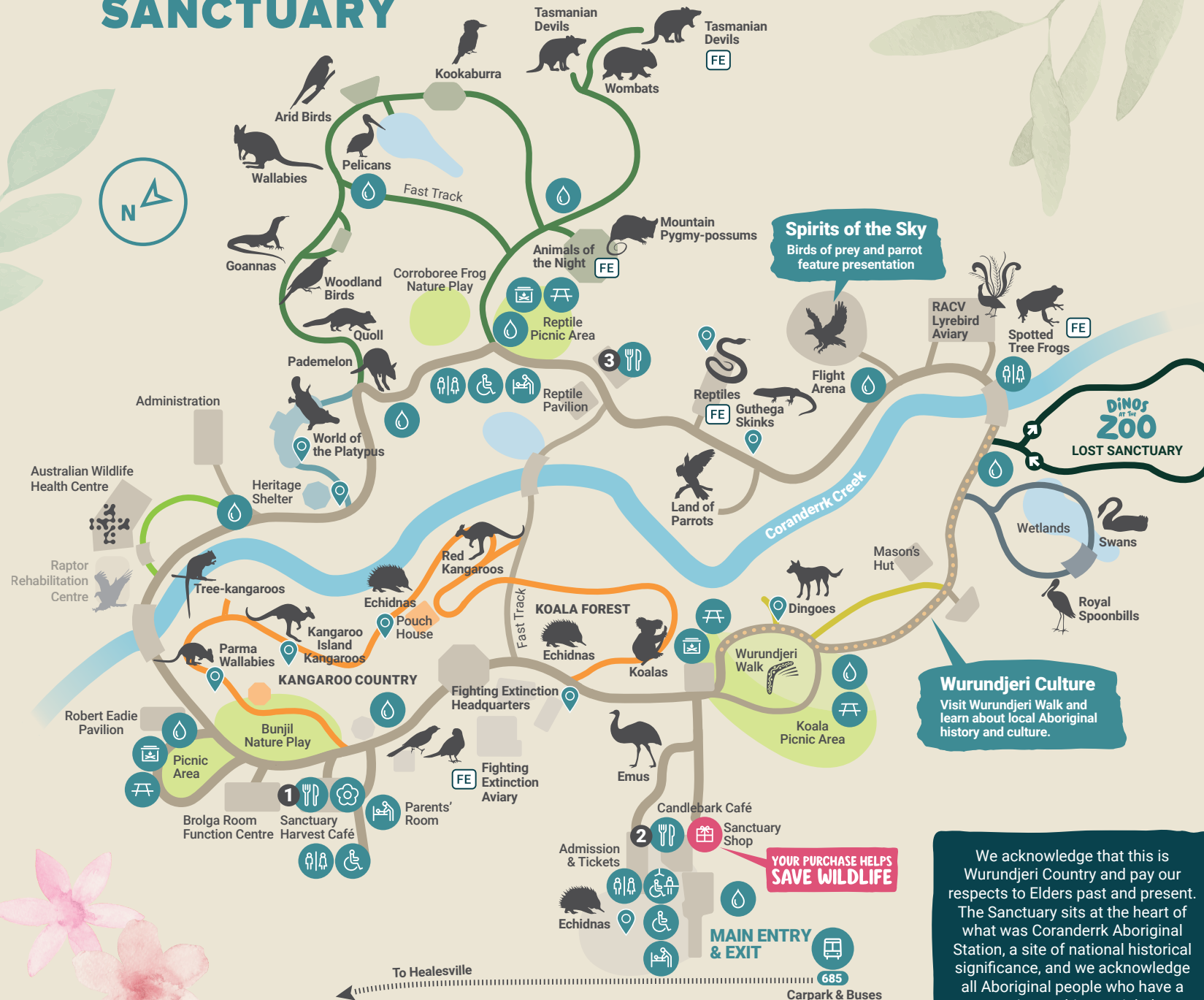
